 - 1.3 Content should not be entirely industry specific unless there is only one supplier of the technology being discussed.
 - 1.3 The presentations are given in English.
 - 1.4 Presenters should disclose all relevant conflict of interests and presentations should be balanced.
 - 1.5 Should be free of promotional, advertising and non-scientific content.

2. The Organizing Party will pay ***USD 3,000** (On-site Program) / ***USD 2,000** (Online Program) to APHRs as the endorsement fee.
 - 2.1 APHRs will provide the logo to the organizing party.
 - 2.2 APHRs will promote the program on its website.
 - 2.3 APHRs will notify its members on the program (upon endorsement and 1 week before the actual program).
 - 2.4 *** The endorsement fee is charged per event / webinar.**

3. The Organizing Party will be responsible for:
 - 3.1 Publishing the program objectives, expected learning outcomes, and instructional format in the program brochure.
 - 3.2 Listing APHRs as an endorser on all promotional materials with APHRs logo.
